**INSURANCE PLAN ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HAVEN, MICHIGAN
ord. no. 23 eff. Aug. 13, 1990**

An ordinance to create and establish a township insurance plan covering life, health, hospitalization, medical and surgical service and expense and accident insurance for certain classes of township officers and employees and their dependents and to authorize the township supervisor and the township clerk to contract, in the name of the township, for such plan; to define those classes of officers and employees who shall be covered by such group insurance plan; to set forth the respective per centum shares which South Haven Township and the officers and employees shall contribute to the premium or charges arising under such insurance plan and to further provide for the deduction of contributions from officers' and employees' compensation; to provide a method of noncoverage of an officer or employee of the insurance plan.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HAVEN, VAN BUREN COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

12.051 Sec. I. SHORT TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "South Haven Township Insurance Plan Ordinance".

12.052 Sec. II. CREATION, ESTABLISHMENT OF PLAN.

Pursuant to Act #27 of the Public Acts of 1960, as amended, the Township of South Haven hereby creates and establishes an insurance plan covering life, health, hospitalization, medical and surgical service and expense and accident insurance for its officers and employees enumerated herein, and their dependents, and for such purposes, also hereby authorizes the township supervisor and the township clerk to contract, in the name of the township, subject to approval of the township board, with any company authorized to transact such business within the State of Michigan for such insurance policies.

12.053 Sec. III. EMPLOYEES COVERED.

The insurance plan created, established and contracted for under this ordinance shall cover each person within the following classes of officers and employees:

All members of the township board.

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12.054 Sec. IV. DEPENDENTS COVERED.

The insurance plan created, established, and contracted for under this ordinance shall cover the dependents of persons described in Section III above.

12.055 Sec. V. CONTRIBUTIONS BY TOWNSHIP; INDIVIDUAL; NONCOVERAGE.

The Township of South Haven shall annually contribute 100 per centum of the portion of the premium or charges arising under such life insurance contract for each person within the class of persons enumerated in Section III hereof. Additionally, the Township of South Haven shall annually contribute 100 per centum of that portion of the premium or charges under such health, hospitalization, medical and surgical service and expense and accident insurance contract for each person within the class of persons enumerated in Section III hereof. Such township contribution shall be secured from the general fund of the township. Each person within such class shall be responsible for the payment of the premium or charges for their dependents as authorized in Section IV above. The township treasurer is hereby authorized to deduct the same from such person's pay, salary or compensation to apply such person's responsibility. Any person desiring not to be so covered shall give written notice to the township clerk that he desires not to be insured or covered, and if the notice is received before the person has become insured or covered under the contract, he shall not be covered thereunder. If the notice is received after the individual has been insured or covered, his coverage under the contract shall cease as provided for in the contract. If the member is covered by health, hospitalization, medical and surgical insurance through other employment plans, the member shall designate one of the employers' insurance plan as the primary plan carrier.

12.056 Sec. VI. APPROVAL OF PLANS, COSTS BY BOARD.

The Township of South Haven Board shall ratify and confirm the particular plans and costs of any life, health, hospitalization, medical and surgical service and expense and accident insurance or any one or more of such forms of insurance selected by the Township Supervisor and proposed to the Township Board.
