ORDINANCE NO. 119

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 36, GARAGE SALE ORDINANCE

SOUTH HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

Section 1. Purpose. The Township adopts the following amendments to Ordinance No. 36, Garage Sale Ordinance, for the health, safety and welfare of Township residents.

Section 2. Amending Ordinance No. 36, Section 20.303. The Township hereby amends Section 20.303 of Ordinance No. 36, Garage Sale Ordinance, to limit the amount of times a parcel can host a garage sale within a 12 month period. The Section, as amended, shall read as follows:

20.303 - Sec. 3. LICENSING.

Such license shall be issued to any one <u>person parcel</u> only two (2) times within a twelve (12) month period and no such license shall be issued for more than two (2) consecutive calendar days.

Each license issued under this Ordinance must be prominently displayed on the premises upon which the garage sale is conducted throughout the entire period of the licensed sale.

Section 3. Amending Ordinance No. 36, Section 20.304. The Township hereby amends Section 20.304 of Ordinance No. 36, Garage Sale Ordinance, to partially amend the procedure for filing information with the Township to conduct a garage sale. The Section, as amended, shall read as follows:

20.304 - Sec. 4. INFORMATION TO BE FILED.

The information to be filed with the elerk <u>Township Hall receptionist</u>, pursuant to this Ordinance, shall be as follows:

- A. Name of person, firm, group, corporation, association, or organization conducting said sale.
- B. Name of owner of the property on which said sale is to be conducted, and consent of owner if applicant is other than the owner.
- C. Location at which sale is to be conducted.
- D. Date, nature of any past sale.
- ED. Number of days of sale.
- FE. Relationship or connection applicant may have had with any other person, firm, group, organization, association, or corporation conducting said sale and the date or dates of such sale.

Section 4. Validity and Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Repealer Clause</u>. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication.
