Ms. Smalley:

The Van Buren County Drain Commissioner is in receipt of a Memorandum from Kimley - Horn introducing a proposed solar array project in South Haven Township. The conclusion of the memorandum states that the engineer does not anticipate an increase in storm water runoff.

The Drain office has some concerns with a more concentrated flow descending from the drip edge of each panel creating a "rivulet" path of release. The Drain Commissioner intends to visit other solar sites to gain a better as -built understanding.

We look forward to the full hydrology report and study mentioned in the memorandum as Kimley-Horns moves toward final design.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Stein at 7:30 p.m.

**April 10, 2024** minutes were accepted as presented.

Gail Gladney was in attendance to report for Van Buren County Commission.

**Motion by Wiatrowski**, supported by Kiry, to approve the Minutes of April 10. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

**Motion by DeGrandchamp,** supported by Wiatrowski, to approve the Agenda. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

**Supervisor Stein** reported that a preliminary site plan has been submitted for 52 apartment units. He also reported that Granicus is just about ready to start receiving the STR applications. Dave Wiatrowski will work with SHAES on the inspections and will be paid \$50.00 an inspection.

**Motion by Wiatrowski**, supported by Kiry, to approve Resolution 24-07 a Resolution to Introduce Ordinance #159 Zoning Text Amendments for cell towers. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.

Van Buren County Board of Commissioners is introducing an ordinance to allow ORV on county roads. Communities can opt out. Trustees gave Commissioner Gladney some feedback and recommended they drop the flag requirement and asked who would be enforcing this. Board members wanted more time to look it over.

Sgt. Zach Hathaway of SHPD was in attendance and gave a report.

**Motion by DeGrandchamp**, supported by Fisher, to accept the Planning Commission's recommendation and approve the Special Use and Site Plan for a Day Care run by Judy Norman. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

**Reports** from various committees and authorities were received. W.C. Askew was in attendance for the Road Commission.

**Motion by Kiry**, supported by Wiatrowski, to approve hiring Williams and Works to update the Zoning Ordinance for \$18,000.00. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

**Motion by DeGrandchamp**, supported by Wiatrowski, to support and approve the SHAWSA Budget. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
