

SOUTH HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
WEDNESDAY, JULY 14, 2021

Present: Stein, Wiatrowski, Kiry, Bertorelli, Fisher, Lewandowski and DeGrandchamp.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Stein at 7:30 p.m.

June 9, 2021 minutes were accepted as presented.

Resident Edward Kowalski was in attendance to discuss handicap accessibility to Deerlick Park. Supervisor Stein said he will check and see what the current grant funds are earmarked for and he will check with Abonmarche to see if a ramp can be engineered at the site. It was also noted that the parking lot needs the stripes repainted.

Motion by DeGrandchamp, supported by Fisher, to accept the Agenda as presented. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Stein reported that he has no new information regarding LIAA Study of Coastal Management.

W.C. Askew, the township Road Commissioner, called the Road Commission and confirmed that they will not install signs on the bridges. Supervisor Stein said that he will check with the sign department at the City of South Haven to see if they will create them for us.

Supervisor Stein reported that he has no new information on the property north of Deerlick. Tasha Smalley, our Zoning Administrator has been communicating with EGLE regarding the property to the south.

Supervisor Stein reported that he has sent a letter of support to SHARC as they seek funding to do a study on high-speed internet in the area.

Motion by Wiatrowski, supported by Lewandowski, to adopt Resolution 21-15 to Adopt Zoning Text Amendments. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by DeGrandchamp, supported by Kiry, to approve renewal of the insurance for the Township and add in the terrorism coverage for a total of \$5244.00. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Kiry, supported by Lewandowski, to set a Public Hearing on August 11th at 7:30 for the Fire Millage. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Reports from various committees and authorities were received. W.C. Askew reported for the Road Commission and Jean Stein reported for the Library.

Motion by Fisher, supported by Kiry, to approve payment of anticipated bills in the amount of \$165,733.93. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Bertorelli, supported by Fisher, to amend the Budget to increase Metro Act Income by \$780.00 and increase Township Hall Expenses by \$22,870.00 to cover the sewer expenses and increase the GIS Mapping & Property Tax Description Expense by \$550.00. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.
